Professionally, Dan is the co-founder, President and CEO of the Prado Group, a privately held real estate development and investment management company that invests in residential, retail and mixed-use properties. Dan received his BA from UC Berkeley and his JD from the UC Hastings College of Law. He is on the Board of Directors of SPUR, a Founding Member of UC Berkeley's Turner Center for Housing Innovation, a member of ULI's Urban Development Mixed-Use Council, and a member of Lambda Alpha International.
