Dan is past Chair of the Jim Joseph Foundation and also past Chair of the San Francisco Jewish Community Endowment Fund, where he also served on the Board, Executive Committee, Finance & Administration, Investment, and Building Committees, and he formerly served as the Chair of the Capital Planning Committee.
